

# The Word of the Laird



Today's celebration of Epiphany recalls the visit of the wise men to Bethlehem. It was a later tradition that considered them to be kings, probably because of the value associated with the gifts they presented to the infant Jesus.

In some churches there is a tradition of inscribing the first three letters associated with the wise men in chalk above the door of the church and then adding to it the year that is just begun. The names attributed to the wise men are Casper. Melchior and Balthasar. The way the inscription would then look would be somewhat like this: "20 C + M + B 24."

I hope that as we continue the celebration of the Christmas season through to the feast of the Baptism of the Lord which this year we celebrate tomorrow, January 8, and then we resume "Ordinary Time" that we carry the goodness of Christ with us in all our endeavors.
