

The Word of the Laird



In the readings for this Sunday's liturgy, we have the account from the Acts of the Apostles about the descent of the Holy Spirit and we also have, from the Gospel of John, Jesus breathing upon the apostles and empowering them with the forgiveness of sins.

The Pentecost account from Acts amounts to a reversal of the episode of the Tower of Babel in Genesis. Where after Babel people were speaking in different languages, with the gift of the Spirit at Pentecost people heard the apostles preaching in their own diverse languages. They marveled at the fact that these rural Galileans were being understood in a variety of tongues.

In the episode reported in John's Gospel the risen Jesus appears to the apostles, greets them with "peace" and then breathes on them bestowing the Holy Spirit and the power to forgive sins. In our sacrament of reconciliation, the beginning of the absolution mirrors this episode when the priest says, "God, the Father of mercies, through the Death and Resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and poured out the Holy Spirit for the forgiveness of sins..."

So today we may be thankful that the church celebrates the gift of the Holy Spirit that has been given to her and that we continue to rejoice in the ways in which that Spirit touches our lives and brings about a positive response to God's Word and to the gift of healing that God extends to us.


