

The Word of the Laird



Today marks the beginning of a new liturgical year. The liturgical year has three distinctions. There is the Advent-Christmas cycle which consists of the four Sundays of Advent and the feasts of Christmas, Mary the Mother of God, Epiphany and the Baptism of the Lord.

The Lent-Easter cycle begins with Ash Wednesday ushering in the season of penitential observance, leading up to Holy Week with the remembrance of the Last Supper, Jesus' Crucifixion and burial, His resurrection on Easter Sunday, forty days leading up to the celebration of the Ascension and ten days on to Pentecost.

The rest of the liturgical year is called "Ordinary Time" and it takes up the remaining thirty-four weeks. During Ordinary Time there are a number of specific feasts and observances such as Trinity Sunday and Christ the King which take the place of the specific Mass for a Sunday in Ordinary Time.

As we begin this new liturgical year let us ask the Lord to help us attune our hearts and minds to the liturgical seasons and participate more fully in the mystery that is Christ's life, death and resurrection which he offered for us so that we become more fully members of His Body.


